**INTERNATIONAL CALL ON BALANCED AND INCLUSIVE EDUCATION  
(ICBIE)**

## PREAMBLE

We, the representatives of Ministries of Education, International Agencies, Academic Bodies and Civil Society Organisations, convening at the Second ForumBIE 2030 in Mexico City, the United Mexican States, from 20 to 22 November 2018:

### MOTIVATED

By our commitment to achieve the United Nations Sustainable Development Goal 4 (SDG 4) by 2030, as the prerequisite for the achievement of all other United Nations Sustainable Development Goals.

### RECALLING

- The UNESCO Universal Declaration on Cultural Diversity (2001);

- The Buenos Aires Declaration (2017);

### RECOGNISING

The role of education in our peoples' economic, social and cultural wellbeing and its benefits on social and community cohesion; as well as the integral part of Balanced and Inclusive Education in the social responsibility of all education institutions.

### ACKNOWLEDGING

- The outcomes of the Regional Stakeholders Consultative Meetings undertaken by the Education Relief Foundation in 2017;
- The outcomes of the I ForumBIE 2030;
- The contribution of the Education Relief Foundation's Global Guide of Ethics, Principles, Policies and Practices in Balanced and Inclusive Education to the understanding of inclusive and equitable quality education;

### AFFIRM

**Our collective aspiration for the realisation of Balanced and Inclusive Education for all through this International Call.**

## **INTERNATIONAL CALL**

1. Celebrating the role of teachers and educators, we call for:
  - a. The revitalisation of the teaching profession, socially and materially, at all levels;
  - b. The transmission of the required knowledge skills and appropriate methods that can foster inclusiveness, through continuous online and onsite capacity building.
2. Acknowledging that academic, governmental bodies, non-governmental and civil society organizations are necessary to embed change, we call for:
  - a. The encouragement and support of academic bodies to research and develop Balanced and Inclusive Education, at all levels;
  - b. Direct collaboration between academic, governmental bodies, communities, non-governmental and civil society organizations in Balanced and Inclusive Education.
3. Recognising that, although national governments are most qualified to determine the context of their nation, the engagement of local authorities, communities, and organisations is necessary to social cohesion and sustainable development, we call for:
  - a. The promotion of partnerships in Balanced and Inclusive Education between those engaged at a national and local level to help determine the mechanisms necessary to enable contextualisation at the local level, whilst preserving national, regional, and international common standards;
  - b. The encouragement and support of local initiatives in Balanced and Inclusive Education;
  - c. The engagement of local communities in Balanced and Inclusive Education to enable them to co-own and co-create;
  - d. The promotion of a holistic student-centred and community-rooted approach.
4. Acknowledging that confederating efforts, initiatives, and actions is essential to face common global challenges and achieve shared objectives, we call for:
  - a. The reinforcement of regional collaborations between Ministries of Education;
  - b. The strengthening of South-South cooperation;
  - c. A collective, shared objective and international cross-sectoral framework for collaboration in Balanced and Inclusive Education.

## **CALL FOR ACTION**

We, therefore, resolve to:

1. Mandate the Education Relief Foundation (ERF), as the convenor of the ForumBIE 2030, to:
  - a. Run pilots, in collaboration with relevant international, national and local stakeholders, for Balanced and Inclusive Education, on the basis of the Global Guide;
  - b. Ensure the contextualisation of the Global Guide;
  - c. Compile and communicate the outcomes of case studies, pilots, and research on Balanced and Inclusive Education;
  - d. Prepare, through consultation meetings with the signatories and other stakeholders over the next 18 to 24 months, a formal draft of a Universal Declaration on Balanced and Inclusive Education;
2. Reconvene in 18 to 24 months for the III ForumBIE 2030 to sign, subject to a successful round of consultation meetings, the Universal Declaration on Balanced and Inclusive Education.
